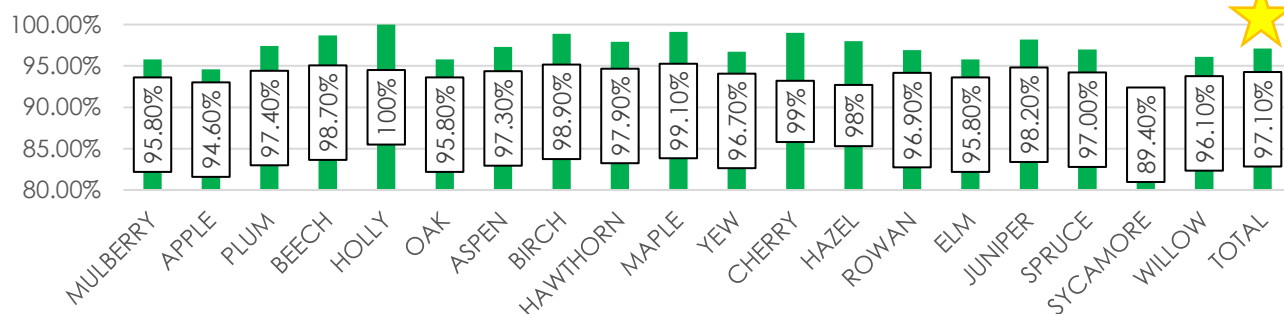
## Attendance
