Covid – Changes to contact tracing and updated guidance

As per the letter sent out on 16th July 2021, this is just a reminder that moving forward school is no longer required to conduct routine contact tracing. Once the summer holidays begin we will therefore revert to the standard NHS process where positive cases will be contacted only by the NHS Test and Trace team to identify close contacts. There is no longer a requirement to let school know. NHS Test and Trace will then work directly with yourselves to identify any close contacts. There will be a standard 'out of office' reply on the school's covid@inbox as a reminder.

Please continue to follow all guidance in the event of your child or household members having symptoms or a positive lateral flow test or PCR test.

From 16th August 2021, if a close contact is under 18, they will not need to self-isolate (in line with policy for fully vaccinated adults) but will be asked to take a PCR test immediately.

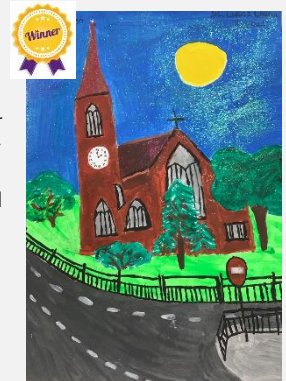
Well done to team **Sherwood** who have won the championship race this term and secured themselves a non-uniform day on the last day of term.

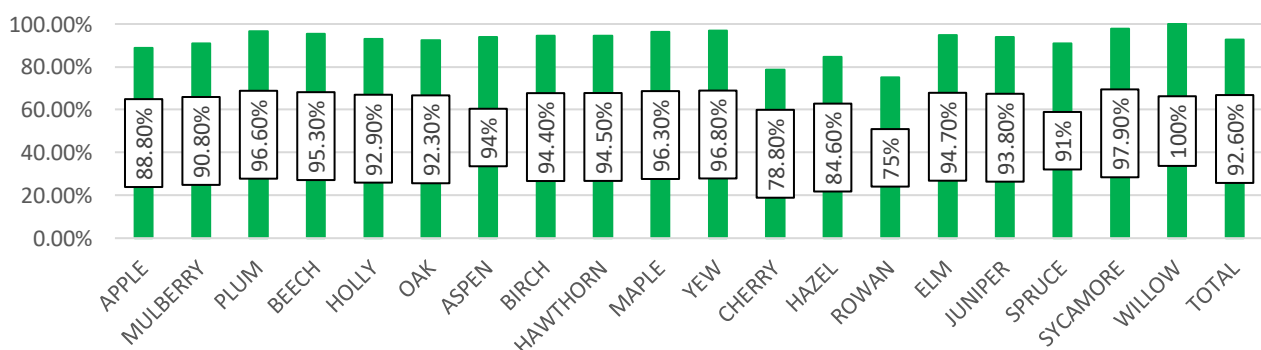
Goodbye and Good Luck Mr Salim
