Dear Parents/Carers,

Unfortunately, as you will know, we currently have a number of classes self-isolating. Please could we remind you to continue to be vigilant in following the guidance to ensure that we keep each other as safe as possible. If any member of your household or a close contact is symptomatic/has gone for a PCR and is awaiting results your child must not come to school until a negative result is confirmed or, in the event of a positive result, has completed the necessary 10 day isolation period. Please do not send your child into school if they are symptomatic. The primary symptoms are: fever/temperature, a cough and the loss of smell/taste. We are also now being advised that if a child displays with any of the following secondary symptoms then a PCR test to rule out Covid is also advised: shortness of breath, muscle aches, chills, sore throat, runny nose, headache, chest pain, conjunctivitis, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea or a rash.

Blended Learners

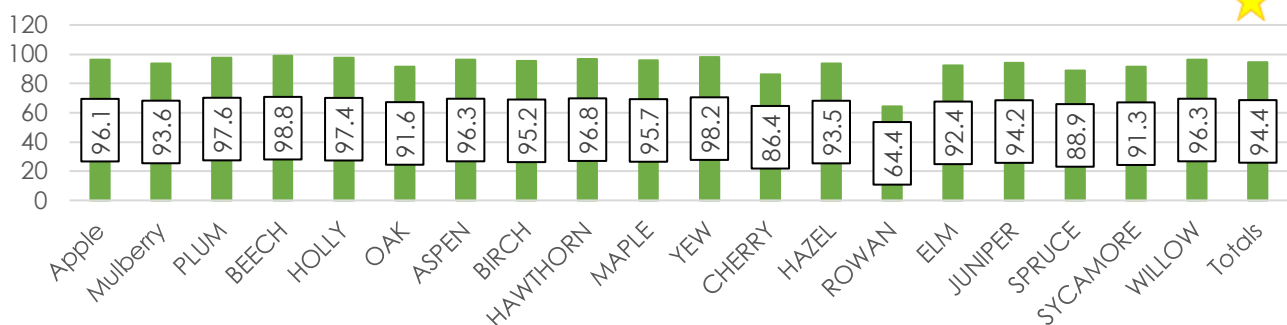
