





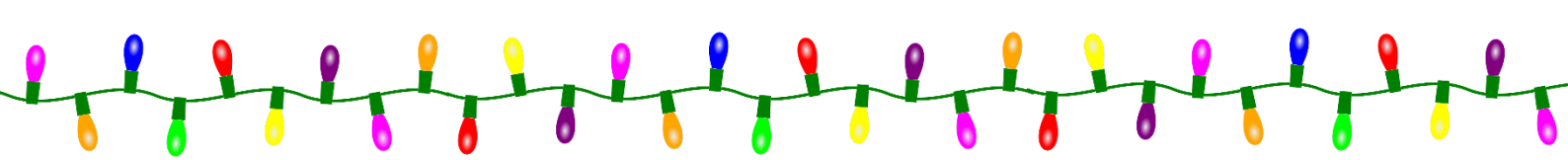

Christmas Cards

These can be sent in from Tuesday 1st December and until Friday 11th December in order to be able to quarantine all cards for 72 hours prior to sending them home.

Homework

We would like to give you the opportunity to create a decoration at home with your child for the Christmas tree in the school hall. Please send them in as they are completed but can we ask that all decorations are sent in **no later than Monday 7th December**.

Non-uniform days Friday 4th and Friday 11th December
