If you could also remind your child that this platform is for dialogue linked to their learning as opposed to it being a social media platform – as per the Code of Conduct – that would be really helpful.

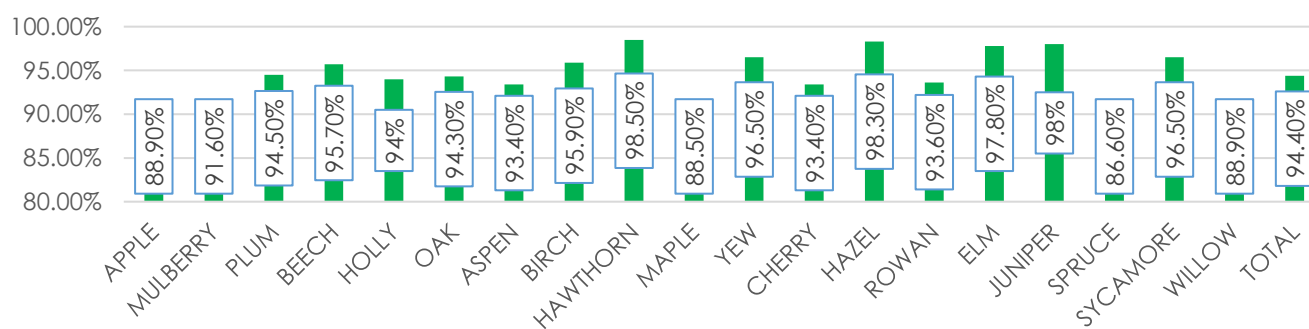
