Christmas

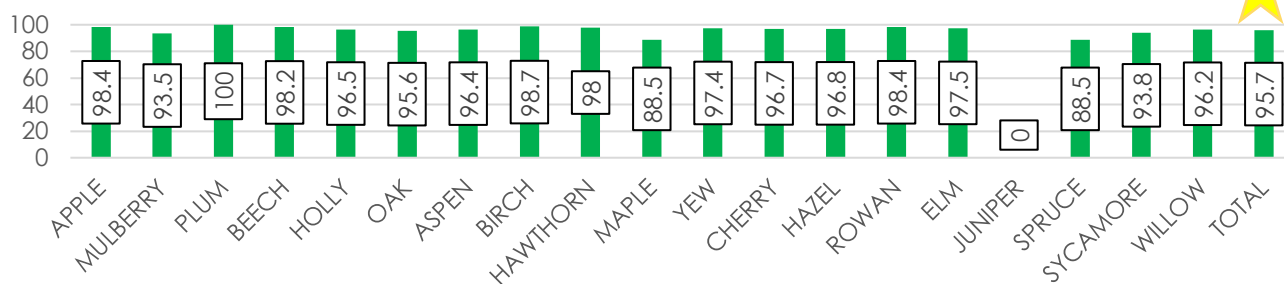
